

The Town of Sturgeon Bay called its monthly Town Board meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. on Monday, May 3, 2021, at the Arle Memorial Hall (Former Knights of Columbus Hall), Chairman Dan Cihlar presiding. Masking was required and social distancing by 6 ft. was put into practice.

Roll call indicated the following Board members present: Chairman Dan Cihlar, Supervisor Paul Skup, Supervisor Carol Schuster, Treasurer Lynne Gustafson, and Clerk Nancy Anschutz.

Meeting Minutes from the April 2021 meeting were read. A motion was made by Chairman Cihlar, 2nd by Supervisor Skup to approve the minutes as read.

Supervisor Skup made a motion to approve the Treasurers Report, 2nd by Chairman Cihlar.

Old Business:

Roads/Signs :

Chairman Cihlar made a motion, 2nd by Supervisor Skup to proceed with the following roadwork for 2021.

- Crackfilling by Fahrner on Shiloh Road, Lily Bay Road and Mathey Road, totaling \$11,235.00
- Smejkal Road – Sweep, apply chips and tar by the DC Hwy. Dept for cost of \$1,575.00.
- 1.25 inch hot mix for Big Creek Road estimated at \$80,450.00
- Estimated road maintenance for 2021 to be \$93,260.00
- Pave 1” heavy wedge compact hot mix asphalt by DC Hwy. Dept on S Lake Michigan Drive, estimated cost \$42,150 will be reviewed at a later date, depending on available money.

Zoning/Permit Issues – None

Neighbor Complaints on Canal Road – Rich Propsom presented a 3 page document listing concerns regarding encroachments on Sturgeon Blvd and Canal Road. The Board recommended Mr. Propsom forward to the County Zoning and Planning office because they are knowledgeable of what is allowed or not allowed on properties.

Update on Crommel’s Grove Survey – Rose Hayes still working on this. Board has not received any legal info at this time.

New Business:

Invasive Treatment Plan for 2021 – Clerk Anschutz reported permission slips have been returned from property owners granting permission to treat invasives, primarily phragmites and Japanese knotweed on their property. Three DC licensed applicators have been mailed a request for price and asked to respond by May 15th.

Town Representative for the DCTZC – A motion was made by Chairman Cihlar, 2nd by Supervisor Skup to appoint Keli Groenfeldt as the Town of Sturgeon Bay representative on the DCTZC. That position has been vacant for several years, so it is good to have this spot filled.

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Bill from SBU – Clerk Anschutz presented a bill from SBU in the amount of \$204.60 for city water used in a fire call in our town in January of 2021. This is the first time we have received something like this. The Board asked Clerk Anschutz to contact the SBU and ask if a representative from the utilities could come to the June meeting and explain the bill.

Clerk Anschutz reported the town printer broke down. She asked Quantum if it could be fixed but they said it could not, so she purchased a new printer – copier.

County Board Update - Representative Sue Kohout was not available for an update.

Public Discussion - Question raised if any report on the Cedar Circle dog issue. Nothing new to report.

Following the review and payment of bills, a motion was made by Chairman Cihlar, 2nd by Supervisor Skup, to adjourn at 8:10 p.m.
