
ORDINANCE NO. 2010-01
Ordinance to Allow Electric Vehicles


Neighborhood Electric Vehicles


- (1) "Neighborhood electric vehicle" (NEV) means any self-propelled electrically-powered motor vehicles, excluding golf carts, that has a maximum speed of 20 to 25 miles per hour, and that has successfully completed the Neighborhood Electric Vehicle America Test Program conducted by the Federal Department of Energy, and that conforms to the definition and requirements for low-speed vehicles as adopted in the Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standards for Low-Speed Vehicles under 49 CFR 571.3(b) and 571.500.
- (2) Neighborhood electric vehicles authorized pursuant to 349.26 Wisconsin Statutes shall be allowed to operate on public roads in the town with the following limitations:
- (a) Operation is limited to roads with a speed limit of 35 mph or less.
 - (b) The vehicle must display a valid NEW registration (license) plate issued by the Wisconsin Department of Transportation.
