

AN ORDINANCE

A JOINT ACTION EMERGENCY SERVICES ORDINANCE BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF DOOR AND MUNICIPALITIES OF _____ TO COPE WITH EMERGENCIES RESULTING FROM ENEMY ACTION AND WITH EMERGENCIES RESULTING FROM MAN-MADE OR NATURAL DISASTERS.

The municipality of Ironwood Sturgeon Bay does ordain as follows:

Section 1. A Joint Action Ordinance of the Board of Supervisors of Door County providing for a county-municipal joint action Emergency Services plan of organization adopted by said County Board on the 2 day of Feb., 1987. A copy of said ordinance is attached hereto, and made a part hereof, by reference, and is hereby ratified and accepted by the municipality of Ironwood Sturgeon Bay County of Door.

This ratification and acceptance of the Joint Action Ordinance shall constitute a Mutual Agreement between the municipality of Ironwood Sturgeon Bay and the County of Door as provided by Section 3 of said Joint Action Ordinance.

Section 2. The County-Municipal Emergency Services Director, appointed and employed by Door County Board as provided in the referred to Ordinance is hereby designated and appointed Emergency Services Director for the municipality of Ironwood Sturgeon Bay subject to the conditions and provisions as set forth in the Wisconsin Statutes, and the Door County Joint Action Ordinance.

Section 3. All ordinances and/or resolutions in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from, and after, its passage and publication.

Section 5. This Ordinance was passed on the 2 of Feb. 1987.
