### **New Business:**

Retrieving Stray Animals – The person who retrieves stray animals in the Town of Forestville was contacted. He is not in the business and only provides that service to the Town of Forestville. This will be an item for discussion at the Towns Annual meeting April 20th. There is an individual from the Egg Harbor area in the business but he would require a salary, insurance, fee for calls responded to and mileage.

Invasive Treatment – Jason Wilke from Nature Care Ecological Consulting and Services provided minimal treatment in 2019. He said it was not enough to charge for.

Treasurer Lynne Gustafson investigated towns with fire protection assessment added to their tax bills, but was not able to get any clarification on this.

Clerk Anschutz reminded the Board at least one person needs to re-certify prior to the 2020 BOR. A video will be ordered when it becomes available, which should be March.
