New Business:

Clerk Anschutz presented the "draft" Ordinance for "*Regulating Noxious Weeds and Invasive Species*". Following review and discussion, it was agreed that two additional invasives should be added. In addition to Phragmites and Wild Parsnip, Japanese Knotweed and Common and/or Cut-Leaved Teasel will be added. Chairman Cihlar made a motion to approve the draft with the two additions, 2nd by Supervisor Skup. Clerk to post for the public in the Door County Advocate and also add to our town website. Krista Lutzke from DC Soil and Water will provide an inventory list where invasives are located in the Town of Sturgeon Bay, along with contact information of contractors certified to remove said invasives.

County Board Activity: Sue Kohout gave a report on County Board activities.

Public Discussion: The Tall Ships event on August 3rd attracted a lot of people to Barge Road and the Canal Park area.
