AN ORDINACE REGULATING ACTIVITIES IN PORTAGE PARK – TOWN OF STURGEON BAY ORDINANCE NO. 2012-01

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Sturgeon Bay, Door County, Wisconsin, has formulated certain rules and regulations pertaining to the use of the town park; and

WHEREAS, for enforcement purposes, it is necessary that these rules and regulations be in ordinance form; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Sturgeon Bay Board find these park rules and regulations to be reasonable and appropriate, in order to secure the health, safety and welfare of the Town of Sturgeon Bay, to provide for the proper use and enjoyment of the park by its users and for their safety and protection and to appropriately regulate the use of the town park;

NOW THEREFORE, the Town Board of the Town of Sturgeon Bay, Door County, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

PARK RULES AND REGULATIONS:

"Dog" means canine regardless of age or sex. No dog shall be allowed in the park unless dog is on a leash and under the control of its owner or some other person.

"Town Park" means Portage Park owned by the Town of Sturgeon Bay, Door County, Wisconsin, located in the town and includes the beach and wooded area situated on the waters of Lake Michigan.

"Curfew" No person shall remain in the park between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m.

ENFORCEMENT:

(1) This Ordinance may be enforced by the issuance of a citation to any violator of this Ordinance by any Sheriff or Deputy Sheriff of the County of Door, State of Wisconsin, or by any State of Wisconsin officer with police powers.

PENALTIES:

By:

Penalties for violations of provisions of this Ordinance shall be as follows:

- \$25.00 to \$100.00 plus costs of prosecution.
- Each violation constitutes a separate offense.

This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication according to law.
