
**REDUCE SPEED LIMIT TO 35 MPH
ON 18TH AVENUE
FROM Delaware Street to Alabama Street**

As a result of a recent study done by the Wisconsin State Traffic Control the recommendation was made to reduce the speed limit in the area designated from 45 MPH to 35 MPH. The Town Board of the Town of Sturgeon Bay accepts this recommendation and reduces the speed limit to 35 MPH in the area designated above. This ordinance is contingent upon the City of Sturgeon Bay accepting the same.


Mr. Michael Nordin, Sturgeon Bay Chief of Police, advised the City will be responsible for erecting one (1) speed limit sign.
