REDUCE SPEED LIMIT TO 35 MPH  
ON BUFFALO RIDGE TRAIL  
BETWEEN MATHEY ROAD AND LAKE FOREST PARK ROAD

The Town Board of the Town of Sturgeon Bay, Door County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s.349.11, Wis. stats., to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the reduction of the speed limit on certain town roads in the town as follows:

- A. Pursuant to s.349.11, Wis. stats., effective September 22, 2014, the speed limit is reduced on Buffalo Ridge Trail between Mathey Road and Lake Forest Park Road to 35 MPH.
- B. Pursuant to s.349.11 (5) Wis. stats., applicable traffic signs will be placed at location described above on or before September 22, 2014.
- C. No person may operate any vehicle on the above noted location in violation of the reduced speed limit. Any violation shall be subject to penalties under s.346.60 Wis. stats.

This ordinance is effective on September 22, 2014.


The town clerk shall property publish this ordinance as required under s.60.80 Wis. Stats.


