ORDINANCE NO. 1-1998

**REDUCE SPEED LIMIT TO 35 MPH
ON LILY BAY ROAD
BETWEEN MICHIGAN AND BIG CREEK ROAD
and 0.2 MILE NORTHEAST OF BIG CREEK ROAD**

As a result of a recent survey completed by the Wisconsin Department of Transportation, District 3, Green Bay, Wisconsin, the following recommendations were made:

- 1) The area of Lily Bay Road between Michigan and Big Creek Road meets the statute definition of a "semi-urban" district. By Town Board action, the town can and *herewith* declares a 35 miles per hour speed limit.
- 2) The Town of Sturgeon Bay would also like to change the speed limit on Lily Bay Road, northeast of Big Creek Road (approximately 0.2 of a mile) to 35 miles per hour. (see map attached) Approval is requested by the Dept. of Transportation by signing below.

The Town of Sturgeon Bay Board agrees with these recommendations This ordinance shall be effective upon public notification.
