## ESTABLISHMENT OF A SPEED ZONE ON NORTH LAKE MICHIGAN DRIVE From Cty. T to TT TOWN OF STURGEON BAY DOOR COUNTY, STATE OF WISCONSIN

The Town of Sturgeon Bay Board contacted the Wisconsin Dept. of Transportation – Green Bay office, seeking recommendations to lower the speed zone on North Lake Michigan Drive. The WDOT responded:

- 1. The Town Board can reduce the fixed speed limit to 35 miles per hour "where on either side of the highway within any 1,000 feet along such highway the buildings in use for business, industrial or residential purposes fronting thereon average not more than 200 feet apart".
- 2. The Chairman did perform a site review and said the area does qualify for a speed reduction to 35 mhp.
- 3. Therefore, the maximum permissible speed at which vehicles may be operated on said road way (North Lake Michigan Drive Cty. T to TT) is herewith established at 35 mph.

The Town of Sturgeon Bay Board makes these recommendations. This ordinance shall be in effect, following public notification and sign erection.
